AN ACT

Amending the act of May 4 1927 (P L 519) entitled "An act concerning boroughs and revising amending and consolidating the law relating to boroughs" permitting boroughs to make appropriations to industrial development agencies

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

4 LXIX Appropriations for Industrial Promotions To make appro-
5 priations to an industrial development agency as defined in section 3 act
6 of May 31 1956 (P L 1911) known as the "Industrial Development
7 Assistance Law" when the borough is located within the area for which
8 the agency has been authorized to make application to and receive
9 grants from the Department of Commerce for the purposes specified
10 in the "Industrial Development Assistance Law" Such appropriations
11 by any borough shall not exceed in any one year ten cents (10¢) for
12 each inhabitant of the borough
