## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 12 1935 (P L 708) entitled "An act prohibiting others than members of the Bar to practice law and providing penalties" defining certain practices as practicing law

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1.1 The furnishing of advice or services for and in behalf  
2 of a debtor in connection with any debt pooling plan whereby such  
3 debtor deposits any funds for the purpose of making pro rata payments  
4 or other distributions to his creditors shall be deemed the practice of law  
5 within the provisions of this act
