## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 1 1933 (P L 103) entitled "An act concern-  
ing townships of the second class and amending revising con-  
solidating and changing the law relating thereto" increasing the  
number of supervisors

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 402 Officers to Be Elected The electors of each township  
2 shall elect (a) [three] five supervisors (b) one assessor (c) three auditors  
3 and (d) one tax collector No person shall at the same time hold more than  
4 one elective township office Provided That the office of justice of the  
5 peace shall not be considered an elective township office for the purposes  
6 of this section
