## AN ACT

Repealing subdivisions (q) and (r) of Article XI act of May 1 1933

(P L 103) entitled "An act concerning townships of the second

class and amending revising consolidating and changing the law

relating thereto" abolishing the right of taxpayers to acquire

the right to furnish all materials and labor necessary for opening

making and repairing township highways and bridges

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

hereby enacts as follows
