AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10 1949 (P L 30) entitled "An act relating to the public school system including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto" providing for reimbursement by the Commonwealth to school districts for the employment of school nurses

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Section 2505 of the act of March 10 1949 (P. L. 30)

3 Section 2505 Payments on Account of School Nurses Every school
4 district and every vocational school district shall be paid by the Com-
5 monwealth for every school year on account of the employment of
6 properly certificated school nurses an amount equal to one reimburse-
7 ment unit for each nurse having the care of [fifteen hundred] seven
8 hundred and fifty or more pupils in average daily membership in the
9 districts' public schools and for each nurse having the care of less than
10 [fifteen hundred] seven hundred and fifty such pupils the fractional
11 part of one reimbursement unit equal to the number of such pupils
12 under her care divided by [fifteen hundred] seven hundred and fifty

13 The reimbursement provided for by this section shall be paid by the
14 Department of Health out of any money appropriated to said depart-
15 ment for administering the provisions of Article fourteen of this act

16 Section 2 This act shall take effect immediately
