AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9 1929 (P L 177) entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments boards commissions and officers thereof including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools or Teachers Colleges abolishing creating reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative departments boards and commissions defining the powers and duties

of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers and of the several administrative departments boards commissions and officers fixing the salaries of the Governor Lieutenant Governor and certain other executive and administrative officers providing for the appointment of certain administrative officers and of all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain departments boards and commissions and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments boards and commissions shall be determined" authorizing the purchase and resale of books by the Historical and Museum Commission

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Article XXVIII-A act of April 29 1929 (P L 177) known
2 as "The Administrative Code of 1929" is amended by adding at the end
3 thereof a new section to read

4 Section 2803-A Historical Publications In order to encourage and
5 promote the economical publication of worthwhile books on the history
6 archaeology art cartography folklore and other cultural elements of
7 Pennsylvania's heritage the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Com-

- 1 mission with the approval of the Governor Auditor General and State
- 2 Treasurer is authorized to enter into agreements with publishers to sub-
- 3 sidize the publishing of books in the said fields by agreeing to purchase
- 4 a sufficient number of copies of a given book to make publication possible
- 5 The said commission may then resell such books at the State Museum or
- 6 at the historic properties in the the same manner as its own publications
