## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 2 1956 (P L 1211) entitled "An act providing for and regulating the licensing and practice of practical nursing imposing duties on the State Board of Nurse Examiners and imposing penalties" providing for biennial licenses

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Sections 12 and 13 act of March 2 1956 (P L 1211) known  
2 as the "Practical Nurse Law" are amended to read

EXPLANATION—CAPITAL LETTERS indicate new matter added to bill. Matter stricken through is to be omitted from bill. Underscoring indicates new matter added to existing law. [Brackets] indicate matter stricken from existing law.

1 Section 12 Each original license issued and recorded under the pro-  
2 visions of this act shall authorize the holder to practice nursing as a  
3 licensed practical nurse from the date of the issuance of said license  
4 until the last day of June [next succeeding] of the year the license was  
5 issued if it was issued prior to the last day of June in an even-numbered  
6 year and until the last day of June in the next succeeding year if it was  
7 issued after the last day of June in an even-numbered year or in an  
8 odd-numbered year unless said license shall be revoked or suspended  
9 for cause as hereinafter provided

10 Section 13 Every licensed practical nurse receiving a license under  
11 the provisions of this act shall [annually] during the month of June of  
12 1962 and biennially thereafter apply for renewal of such license where-  
13 upon the board shall upon the payment of the fee of [one dollar (\$1.00)]  
14 two dollars (\$2.00) issue a renewal of said license for the term of one  
15 year and such renewal shall be duly recorded as hereinbefore provided
