AN ACT

Amending the act of June 24 1939 (P L 872) entitled "An act to consolidate amend and revise the penal laws of the Commonwealth" prohibiting the use of railroad passenger station facilities by loiterers

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 The act of June 24 1939 (P L 872) known as "The Penal
- 2 Code" is amended by adding after section 699.13 a new section to read

1 Section 699.14 Loiterers in Railway Passenger Stations and Plat-
2 forms Any person who shall loiter idle or lounge in on or about any
3 railroad or railway passenger station or platform other than in the
4 course of using it for the purpose for which it exists is guilty of a
5 summary offense and upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding
6 shall be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding fifty dollars (\$50) and
7 the cost of prosecution and in default of the payment thereof shall
8 undergo imprisonment for not more than five (5) days.
