AN ACT

Amending the act of April 29 1959 (P L 58) entitled "An act consolidating and revising the Vehicle Code the Tractor Code the Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act and other acts relating to the ownership possession and use of vehicles and tractors" removing nonresident provisions and providing for filing surety bonds after accidents

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

6 (b) The secretary shall within sixty (60) days after the receipt
7 of such report of a motor vehicle accident suspend the license of each
8 operator and all registrations of each owner of a motor vehicle in any
9 manner involved in such accident [and if such operator is a nonresident
10 the privilege of operating a motor vehicle within this State and if such
11 owner is a nonresident the privilege of the use within this State of any
12 motor vehicle owned by him] unless such operator or owner or both
13 shall deposit security or shall file with the secretary a surety bond
14 after such accident covering any judgment for damages as a result of
15 such accident in the sum so determined by the secretary Notice of such
16 suspension shall be sent by the secretary to such operator and owner
17 not less than ten (10) days prior to the effective date of such suspen-
18 sion and shall state the amount required as security Where erroneous in-
19 formation is given the secretary with respect to the matters set forth

1 in clause (1) (2) or (3) of subsection (c) of this section he shall take
 2 appropriate action as hereinbefore provided within sixty (60) days after
 3 receipt by him of correct information with respect to such matters
