AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9 1929 (P L 177) entitled "An act provid-
ing for and reorganizing the conduct of the executive and ad-
ministrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive De-
partment thereof and the administrative departments boards
commissions and officers thereof including the boards of trustees
of State Normal Schools or Teachers Colleges abolishing creat-
ing reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain
administrative departments boards and commissions defining the

powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers and of the several administrative departments boards commissions and officers fixing the salaries of the Governor Lieutenant Governor and certain other executive and administrative officers providing for the appointment of certain administrative officers and of all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain departments boards and commissions and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments boards and commissions shall be determined" providing for the medical and surgical care of inmates of State institutions in State-aided hospitals and for reimbursement to the State for the cost thereof

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 The act of April 9 1929 (P L 177) known as "The Ad-
2 ministrative Code of 1929" is amended by adding after section 528 a
3 new section to read

4 Section 529 Inmates May be Transferred to State-aided Hospitals
5 Under such regulations as may be prescribed by the department board

1 or commission having supervisory powers over a State institution any
 2 inmate thereof may be transferred to a State-aided hospital for medical
 3 or surgical care for which care the State-aided hospital shall be paid
 4 at the standard rates which it charges for the same care of other per-
 5 sons Whenever the State shall be entitled to reimbursement for the
 6 maintenance or care of the inmate the amount paid under this section
 7 for his medical or surgical care in a State-aided hospital shall be in-
 8 cluded in such reimbursement
