3 Section 58 In addition to exemptions now allowed by law any person
4 who shall have performed duty in any military organization of the
5 National Guard of the State for the period of nine years or who en-
6 listed for nine months or a longer period in active service of the United
7 States and was honorably discharged shall be exempt for further military
8 service except in case of war invasion or insurrection and from serving
9 as a juror if he so desires
