AN ACT

Amending the act of April 22 1953 (P L. 184) entitled "An act to continue the imposition of the tax on gross premiums premium deposits and assessments received from business transacted within this Commonwealth by foreign insurance companies associations and exchanges" authorizing certain firemen's relief fund associations to send delegates to district and State firemen's conventions and to reimburse the delegates for expenses and mileage from moneys distributed to them pursuant to the act

EXPLANATION—CAPITAL LETTERS indicate new matter added to bill. Matter stricken through is to be omitted from bill. Underscoring indicates new matter added to existing law. [Brackets] indicate matter stricken from existing law.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 The act of April 22 1953 (P L 184) entitled "An act
2 to continue the imposition of the tax on gross premiums premium de-
3 posits and assessments received from business transacted within this
4 Commonwealth by foreign insurance companies associations and ex-
5 changes" is amended by adding after section 2 a new section to read

6 Section 2.1 Any firemen's relief fund association situated within
7 a city borough town or township having a population in excess of
8 seven thousand five hundred persons as ascertained by reference to
9 the latest Federal census may designate a delegate to attend the dis-
10 trict or State firemen's convention in order to participate in the dis-
11 ussions involving the proper management control protection and in-
12 vestment of the firemen's relief funds

13 The relief fund association may by resolution reimburse said
14 delegate from the moneys distributed to it pursuant to this act for
15 his expenses incurred in attending the meeting at the rate of twenty
16 dollars (\$20) per day together with eight cents (8¢) per mile in going
17 to and returning from the meeting Such reimbursement may be allowed

1 only for conventions which shall not continue for more than four
 2 days including the time employed in going to and returning from the
 3 convention

4 Section 2 This act shall take effect immediately
