AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Department of Public Welfare to purchase the Rush Hospital in Philadelphia and to convert the same into a home for the aged

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 The sum of six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000)
