AN ACT

Amending the act of June 4 1937 (P L 1625) entitled "An act providing for the creation maintenance and operation of a county employees' retirement system in counties of the third class and imposing certain charges on counties" clarifying the provisions of existing law

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

5 December 16 1959 (P L 1851) is reenacted and amended to read

6 Section 10 Service Allowance In computing the length of service
7 of a contributor for retirement purposes full credit shall be given to
8 each original member for each year of service rendered to the county
9 prior to January first of the year the retirement system was established
10 This shall include the services of a county official whose compensation
11 was in the form of fees collected by his office and shall also include
12 the services of employes paid directly by such county official out of such
13 fees Full credit shall also be given for each year of service of a con-
14 tributor who was a per diem employe of the county for a period of at
15 least five years prior to the time the system became effective and
16 who averaged at least two hundred days of employment in each of
17 such years As soon as practicable the retirement board shall issue to
18 each original member a certificate certifying the aggregate length of
19 his service prior to January first of the year retirement system was
20 established Such certificate shall be final and conclusive as to his

1 prior service unless thereafter modified by the board upon application
2 of the member The retirement board may also give credit to any
3 person who was a county employe for each year that he was employed
4 for at least two hundred days per year on a per diem basis for the
5 purpose of the computation of his retirement credit upon payment by
6 the employe of the amount which the retirement board determines
7 should have been his contribution during such period Such payment
8 may be made in installments over a period fixed by the retirement
9 board The time during which a member is absent from service without
10 pay shall not be counted in computing the service of a contributor unless
11 allowed by the county commissioners and approved by the board
12 Section 2 This act shall take effect immediately
