AN ACT

Amending the act of May 10 1939 (P L 111) entitled "An act relating to and providing for the promotion and development of business industry and commerce in the Commonwealth conferring powers and duties upon the Department of Commerce and other agencies of the Commonwealth abolishing the Pennsylvania State Publicity Commission terminating the terms of its members and conferring its powers upon and transferring and appropriating

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Section 3 act of May 10 1939 (P L 111) known as the
2 "Commerce Law" is amended by adding at the end thereof a new
3 clause to read

4 Section 3 The Department of Commerce shall have the power
5 and its duty shall be

7 (14) To assist persons in the development of new products by
8 lending capital funds for the establishment of research facilities When
9 making such loans there shall be no requirement for participation by
10 the county municipality or township where the research facilities are
11 to be located
