AN ACT

Amending the act of June 15 1871 (P L 387) entitled "An act providing for the entry of certain proceedings on the judgment indexes of the several courts of this commonwealth" changing the place of indexing certain proceedings

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

7 Section 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
8 tives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met
9 and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That when any pro-
10 ceedings in lunacy habitual drunkenness to revive and continue the
11 lien of debts against a decedent's real estate by bill or otherwise or a
12 petition to declare void any agreement deed or other paper or pro-
13 ceeding conveying or vesting title to real estate in this commonwealth
14 or any other proceeding by which purchasers of real estate would be
15 deemed to have had constructive notice shall have been commenced
16 in any of the courts of this commonwealth it shall be the duty of the
17 several prothonotaries and clerks to enter the same upon either the
18 judgment or ejectment and miscellaneous indexes or dockets of said
19 courts as directed by local rules of court and to certify the same as

1 liens in any certificate of liens that they may be required to make
2 by virtue of their office

3 Section 2 Section 1 act of May 22 1878 (P L 95) entitled "An act
4 requiring the prothonotary of the several courts of common pleas in
5 this commonwealth to keep separate dockets in certain cases" and its
6 amendments are repealed insofar as they are inconsistent herewith

7 Section 3 This act shall take effect immediately
