AN ACT

Amending the act of June 4 1945 (P L 1388) entitled "An act relating to the practice procedure regulations and adjudications of departments departmental administrative boards and commissions independent administrative boards and commissions officers and other administrative agencies of this Commonwealth and judicial review thereof and preserving equitable jurisdiction in certain cases" providing that regulations shall not become effective until printed and made available for public distribution by the adopting agency

EXPLANATION—CAPITAL LETTERS indicate new matter added to bill. Matter stricken through is to be omitted from bill. Underscoring indicates new matter added to existing law. [Brackets] indicate matter stricken from existing law.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

4 Section 21 Regulations All regulations of any agency which are
5 in effect on the first day of June one thousand nine hundred fifty-two
6 shall expire on the first day of July one thousand nine hundred fifty-
7 two unless a copy thereof certified by the executive officer chairman
8 or secretary of the agency is filed in the Department of State in such
9 form and size as shall be prescribed by the Department of State prior
10 to the first day of July one thousand nine hundred fifty-two Regulations
11 adopted after the thirty-first day of May one thousand nine hundred
12 fifty-two shall have no effect until a copy thereof certified by the execu-
81 tive officer chairman or secretary of the agency is filed in the Depart-
L1 ment of State in such form and size as shall be prescribed by the De-
91 partment of State [Printing of copies of regulations filed with the
91 Department of State shall not be required] Regulations adopted after
11 September 1 1961 shall have no effect until copies of such regulations
81 have been printed by the adopting agency and are available for public

1 distribution and a copy thereof certified by the executive officer chair-
 2 man or secretary of the agency is filed in the Department of State in
 3 such form and size as shall be prescribed by the Department of State
 4 All regulations shall be approved as to legality by the Department
 5 of Justice before they are filed in the Department of State but failure
 6 of the agency to submit a regulation for such approval shall not in-
 7 validate the regulation Copies of all regulations shall be made avail-
 8 able by the adopting agency upon request

9 Section 2 This act shall take effect September 1 1961
