AN ACT

Amending the act of April 12 1951 (P L 90) entitled "An act relating to alcoholic liquors alcohol and malt and brewed beverages amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto regulating and restricting the manufacture purchase sale possession consumption importation transportation furnishing holding in bond holding in storage traffic in and use of alcoholic liquors alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the persons engaged or employed therein defining the powers and duties of

the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board providing for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores for the payment of certain license fees to the respective municipalities and townships for the abatement of certain nuisances and in certain cases for search and seizure without warrant prescribing penalties and forfeitures providing for local option and repealing existing laws" permitting retail licensees to furnish free cheese

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Clause (9) of section 493 act of April 12 1951 (P L 90)
2 known as the "Liquor Code" is amended to read

3 Section 493 Unlawful Acts Relative to Liquor Malt and Brewed
4 Beverages and Licensees The term "licensee" when used in this section
5 shall mean those persons licensed under the provisions of Article IV
6 unless the context clearly indicates otherwise

7 It shall be unlawful

9 (9) Retail Licensees Furnishing Free Lunch etc For any retail
