AN ACT

Amending the act of June 23 1931 (P L. 932) entitled "An act relating to cities of the third class and amending revising and consolidating the law relating thereto" providing for the creation by ordinance of the office of city manager

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

2 The council shall determine the powers and duties to be performed by
3 and assign them to the appropriate department shall prescribe the
4 powers and duties of officers and employes may assign particular offi-
5 cers and employes to one or more of the departments may at its dis-
6 cretion at any time create by ordinance the office of city manager and
7 may in like manner abolish the same While said office of manager
8 exists the council shall from time to time and whenever there is a
9 vacaney elect by a vote of a majority of all the members one person to
10 fill said office subject to removal by council at any time by a vote of
11 the majority of the members The powers duties and compensation
12 of the city manager shall be regulated by ordinance He shall give
13 a bond to the city with one or more sureties or one bonding com-
14 pany to be approved by the council in such sum as it shall by ordi-
15 nance direct conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties
16 The offices of city manager and street commissioner shall not be
17 deemed incompatible Neither the mayor nor any member of the
18 city council shall be eligible to hold the office of city manager The
19 city council may require an officer or employe to perform duties in
20 two or more departments and may make such other rules and regu-

1 lations as may be deemed necessary or proper for the efficient and

2 economical conduct of the business of the city

3 Section 2 This act shall take effect immediately
