AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Trustees of the Pennsylvania State University for the use of the School of Agriculture for the erection of experimental mushroom houses and research in the communicable diseases of mushrooms and other phases of the mushroom industry

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 The sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) or as much
2 thereof as may be necessary is appropriated to the Trustees of the
3 Pennsylvania State University for the fiscal period beginning June 1
4 1961 for the use of the School of Agriculture for expenditure by the
5 Agriculture Experiment Station for the erection of experimental mush-
6 room houses and research in the communicable diseases of mushrooms
7 and other phases of the mushroom industry
