AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10 1949 (P L 30) entitled "An act relating to the public school system including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto" classifying film film strips transparencies records and tapes as school supplies of the first class

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

5 supplies shall be divided into two classes The first class shall include
6 school desks chairs furniture typewriters and school apparatus The sec-
7 ond class shall include all other supplies except maps globes charts edu-
8 cational films filmstrips prepared transparencies and slides pre-recorded
9 magnetic tapes and disc recordings and textbooks necessary for school
10 use not included in the first class The board of school directors in any
11 district may authorize or appoint the secretary of the board or other
12 executive as purchasing agent for the district with authority to purchase
13 supplies of either class costing less than three hundred dollars (\$300)
