AN ACT

Amending the act of April 27 1927 (P L. 465) entitled as amended

“An act to provide for the safety of persons employed housed or assembled in certain buildings and structures not in cities of the first class second class and second class A by requiring certain construction and ways of egress equipment and maintenance providing for the licensing of projectionists except in cities of the first class and second class requiring the submission of plans for examination and approval providing for the promulgation of rules and regulations for the enforcement of this act

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

2 Section 4.1 Fire Extinguishers In addition to such other rules and
3 regulations as the Department of Labor and Industry shall adopt relat-
4 ing to the locations types and number of fire extinguishers in the several
5 classes of buildings covered by this act it shall require that all fire
6 extinguishers which are installed or stored in a closet or recessed in a
7 wall or otherwise obscured from view shall be marked over the door
8 to such closet or over such recess or at the nearest point to such ob-
9 scured location which is readily visible with a light of such size and
10 color as the said department may prescribe so that the location of any
11 such fire extinguisher may be immediately ascertained in emergencies
