AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Downingtown Industrial and Agricultural School Downingtown Pennsylvania

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 The sum of ninety-four thousand four hundred fifty-seven
- 2 (\$94,457) or as much thereof as may be necessary is hereby specifically
- 3 appropriated to the Downingtown Industrial and Agricultural School
- 4 at Downingtown Pennsylvania for the fiscal period June 1 1961 to
