AN ACT

Limiting landowner's liability for personal injuries suffered by any person while hunting or fishing upon or who has entered for his own purposes on the landowner's property

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 No landowner shall be liable for the payment of damages
- 2 for any personal injury suffered by any person while hunting or fishing
- 3 upon or who has entered for his own purposes on the landowner's prop-
