AN ACT

Authorizing certain firemen's relief fund associations to send delegates to State firemen's conventions and to reimburse the delegates for expenses and mileage from moneys distributed to them from the taxes paid by foreign fire insurance companies

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 Any firemen's relief fund association which represents
2 all the volunteer fire companies in any one municipality or township may
3 designate one delegate and in those municipalities or townships where

1 there are more than one firemen's relief fund association the several
2 boards of directors or trustees may jointly designate one delegate to
3 attend the State firemen's convention in order to participate in the dis-
4 cussions involving the proper management control protection and in-
5 vestment of the firemen's relief funds

6 The relief fund association may by resolution reimburse said dele-
7 gate from the moneys distributed to it pursuant to section 2 of the act of
8 June 28 1895 (P L 408) and its amendments for his expenses incurred
9 in attending the meeting at the rate of twenty dollars (\$20) per day
10 not exceeding a total of four days including the time employed in going
11 to and returning from said State convention together with eight cents
12 (8¢) per mile in going to and returning from the meeting

13 Where the delegate is designated to represent the firemen's re-
14 lief associations in those municipalities or townships where more than
15 one such association exists each participating relief association shall
16 bear a portion of this expense and mileage arrived at by mutual agree-
17 ment

18 Section 2 This act shall take effect immediately
