A JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to article three section thirteen of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania prohibiting the amount of expenses paid to any public officer after his election or appointment from being increased or diminished

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby resolves as follows

- 1 Section 1 The following amendment to the Constitution of the
- 2 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with the pro-
- 3 visions of the eighteenth article thereof

1 That section thirteen article three of the Constitution of the Com-
2 monwealth of Pennsylvania be amended to read

3 Section 13 No law shall extend the term of any public officer or in-
4 crease or diminish his salary expense allowance or emoluments after his
5 election or appointment All payments to any public officer for increased
6 expense allowances made after his election or appointment to office sub-
7 sequent to December 1 1960 shall be refunded by such officer to the
8 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or political subdivision thereof which
9 made such payments
