AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10 1949 (P L 30) entitled "An act relating to the public school system including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto" increasing the salaries of certain county superintendents

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Section 1066 act of March 10 1949 (P L 30) known as
2 the "Public School Code of 1949" amended June 1 1956 (P L 1948) is
3 amended to read

4 Section 1066 Minimum Salaries Payment All county superin-
5 tendents assistant county superintendents and supervisors of special
6 education shall be entitled to the following minimum annual salaries

7 (1) County superintendents in counties having a population of less
8 than forty-five thousand (45,000) nine thousand dollars (\$9000)

9 (2) County superintendents in counties having a population of forty-
10 five thousand (45,000) and more but less than one hundred fifty thou-
11 sand (150,000) ten thousand dollars (\$10,000)

12 (2.1) Where the services of a county superintendent extend over
13 parts of one or more counties and the school population exceeds the
14 political population as stated in clauses (1) and (2) of this section
15 the county superintendent shall receive an additional one thousand
16 dollars (\$1000) for his services over the amount stated in clauses (1)
17 and (2) of this section

18 (3) County superintendents in counties having a population of one
19 hundred fifty thousand (150,000) or more eleven thousand dollars
20 (\$11,000)

1 (4) Assistant county superintendents in all counties eight thousand
2 five hundred dollars (\$8500)

3 (5) County supervisors of special education in all counties eight
4 thousand dollars (\$8000)

5 The foregoing salaries shall be paid by the Commonwealth from
6 appropriations made for this purpose or from the appropriations for the
7 public schools except in the case of a full-time supervisor of special
8 education appointed in any county in which there are fewer than five
9 hundred fifty (550) teachers in the school districts of the county and of
10 school districts of other counties whose directors are eligible to vote
11 in county conventions and special meetings in which case the Common-
12 wealth shall pay a fractional part of the minimum salary equal to the
13 number of teachers in school districts whose directors are eligible to
14 vote in county conventions and special meetings divided by five hundred
15 fifty (550) The balance of such minimum salary shall be apportioned
16 among and be paid by the several districts entitled under this act to
17 services provided through the office of the county superintendent in the
18 manner provided in section one thousand sixty-seven of the act to which
19 this is an amendment

20 Section 2 This act shall take effect immediately
