**AN ACT**

Amending the act of June 23 1931 (P L 932) entitled "An act relating to cities of the third class and amending revising and consolidating the law relating thereto" fixing minimum salaries for paid firemen

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 Section 2102 act of June 23 1931 (P L 932) known as

1 Section 2102 Paid Bureau Election of Officers and Companies  
 2 When a paid fire bureau is organized by any city the council may pro-  
 3 vide by ordinance for the election or appointment of the officers and  
 4 companies belonging thereto in accordance with civil service provisions  
 5 where applicable The minimum annual starting salary or compensation  
 6 to be paid the officers and firemen by any city shall be three thousand  
 7 five hundred dollars (\$3500) with minimum annual increments of  
 8 three hundred dollars (\$300) for the first five years of such employment
