The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

11 Section 10 When any judge learned in the law is called in as is
12 now provided by law to assist the judge or judges of any other judicial
13 district the judge so called in shall be entitled to receive for each day
14 he is actually engaged in the performance of such duty the sum of
15 fifty dollars (\$50) per day and the actual traveling expenses not in

1 excess of ten cents (10¢) for each mile traveled to and from the place
2 of holding court in such district and the judges learned in the law of
3 the Commonwealth shall be paid a per diem allowance of twenty
4 dollars (\$20) and actual traveling expenses not to exceed eight cents
5 (8¢) for each mile traveled to and from the State Judicial Conference
6 when called by the Chief Justice of the Commonwealth the annual
7 meeting of the Pennsylvania Council of Juvenile Court Judges and
8 the annual meeting of the National Council of Juvenile Court Judges
9 when duly elected by the State Council as delegates thereto The per
10 diem allowance shall be payable for each day spent by a judge at such
11 conferences and in necessary travel to and from such conferences
