AN ACT

Amending the act of June 12 1931 (P L 510) entitled as amended "An act providing for the licensure and regulation of certain private nursing homes private convalescent homes and private hospitals conferring certain powers and duties upon the Department of Welfare and providing penalties" authorizing appeals to the courts of common pleas of the counties wherein the homes and hospitals are located

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 The act of June 12 1931 (P L 510) entitled as amended
2 "An act providing for the licensure and regulation of certain private
3 nursing homes private convalescent homes and private hospitals con-
4 ferring certain powers and duties upon the Department of Welfare and
5 providing penalties" is amended by adding after section 6 thereof a new
6 section to read

7 Section 6.1 Any person copartnership association or corporation
8 aggrieved by any action of the Department of Public Welfare with
9 respect to refusal to grant refusal to renew or the revocation of a
10 license for any private nursing home private convalescent home or
11 private hospital may within thirty days after notice of such action file
12 a petition in the court of common pleas of the county wherein the
13 private nursing home private convalescent home or private hospital is
14 located for a hearing de novo to determine whether the action of the
15 department is lawful and reasonable The court shall hear the petition and
16 may make any appropriate order or decree
