A JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to article three section eighteen of the Con-
stitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania providing for
grants or loans to residents of the Commonwealth for higher
educational purposes

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows

EXPLANATION—CAPITAL LETTERS indicate new matter added to bill. Matter stricken through is to be omitted from bill. Underscoring indicates new matter added to existing law. [Brackets] indicate matter stricken from existing law.

1 Section 1 The following amendment to the Constitution of the
2 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with the pro-
3 visions of the eighteenth article thereof

4 That section eighteen article three of the Constitution of the Com-
5 monwealth of Pennsylvania be amended to read

6 Section 18 No appropriation shall be made for charitable educa-
7 tional or benevolent purposes to any person or community nor to any
8 denominational and sectarian institution corporation or association Pro-
9 vided That appropriations may be made for pensions or gratuities for
10 military service and to blind persons twenty-one years of age and up-
11 wards and for assistance to mothers having dependent children and to
12 aged persons without adequate means of support and in the form of
13 scholarship grants or loans for higher educational purposes to residents
14 of the Commonwealth enrolled in institutions of higher learning except
15 that no scholarship grants or loans for higher educational purposes shall
16 be given to persons enrolled in a theological seminary or school of
17 theology
