AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10 1949 (P L 30) entitled "An act relating to the public school system including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto" removing provisions relating to the districting of State colleges

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

hereby enacts as follows
