AN ACT

Fixing the salaries and compensation of members of certain boards and
commissions and repealing inconsistent acts

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 Annual salaries shall be payable in equal installments
- 2 every other week as follows
- 3 To the Chairman of the Pennsylvania Board of Parole . . \$17,000
- 4 To the members of the Pennsylvania Board of Parole
