AN ACT

Making an appropriation to Western Pennsylvania School for Blind
Children in Pittsburgh

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 The sum of fourteen thousand seven hundred forty-three
- 2 dollars and forty-six cents (\$14,743.46) or as much thereof as may be
- 3 necessary is hereby appropriated to Western Pennsylvania School for
- 4 Blind Children in Pittsburgh Pennsylvania to pay deficits incurred by
