AN ACT

Making an appropriation to Western Pennsylvania School for the Deaf
in Edgewood Pittsburgh

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 The sum of twenty thousand six hundred seventy-eight
- 2 dollars and sixty-six cents (\$20,678.66) or as much thereof as may be
- 3 necessary is hereby appropriated to Western Pennsylvania School for
- 4 the Deaf in Edgewood Pittsburgh to pay deficits incurred by said school
