**AN ACT**

Making an appropriation to The Pennsylvania School for the Deaf in  
Philadelphia

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
hereby enacts as follows

- 3 necessary is hereby appropriated to The Pennsylvania School for the
