**AN ACT**

Amending the act of June 1 1959 (P L 350) entitled "An act relating to the retirement of public school employes amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto" FURTHER DEFINING CONTRIBUTORY SERVICE AND further regulating contributions on account of past service

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

4 SECTION 205 CONTRIBUTORY SERVICE CONTRIBUTORY

18 SECTION 2 SUBSECTION (6) OF SECTION 302 OF THE ACT  
19 IS AMENDED TO READ

1 Section 302 Members' Contributions on Account of Past Service

2 \* \* \*

3 (6) Any school employe entitled to credit under the provisions  
4 of article II section 209 shall pay in addition to the regular contributions  
5 required in section 301 of this article a sum equal to all back payments  
6 which he would have been required to make for the period of his ap-  
7 proved leave of absence and in addition a sum equal to all contributions  
8 which would have been made on his behalf by the school district and  
9 the Commonwealth if the employe had been in full-time regular daily  
10 attendance rather than on leave of absence Such back payments may  
11 be made in a lump sum by installments or by an increased rate of con-  
12 tribution agreed upon between the contributor and the retirement  
13 board Provided however That all such payments must be made on or  
14 before July 1 [1959] 1963 or within three (3) years after termination  
15 of an approved leave of absence 1962
