## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 29 1959 (P L 58) entitled "An act consolidating and revising the Vehicle Code the Tractor Code the Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act and other acts relating to the ownership possession and use of vehicles and tractors" changing the name of the Italian-American World War Veterans of the United States Incorporated to conform with its charter

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

hereby enacts as follows

3 Section 729 Exemptions from Fees

4 (a) No fee shall be charged for a certificate of title or registration  
5 of motor vehicles tractors fire department equipment trailers and semi-  
6 trailers owned by and used exclusively in the performance of the duties  
7 of (1) the Federal Government (2) any state other than Pennsylvania  
8 which issues titles or registrations to this Commonwealth without charge  
9 (3) the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (4) any city borough incorpo-  
10 rated town township county county institution district or school dis-  
11 trict of this Commonwealth (5) the Civil Air Patrol and duly authorized  
12 volunteer fire force in the extinguishment and prevention of fires or in  
13 rescue work hospital humane society or anticruelty society in this Com-  
14 monwealth (6) the American Red Cross (7) churches (8) Girl Scouts  
15 of America (9) Boy Scouts of America (10) Salvation Army (11) duly  
16 chartered post organization or combination of organizations of the Amer-

8 general consuls and vice consuls who are nationals of the country ap-  
9 pointing them and who are assigned to foreign consulates in this Com-  
10 monwealth Provided That American consular officers of equal rank who  
11 are citizens of the United States and who exercise their official functions  
12 at American consulates in such foreign country are granted reciprocal  
13 exemptions No fee shall be charged for certificates of title or registration  
14 of one (1) motor vehicle owned and used by any veteran who served in  
15 the armed forces of the United States during any period of war or armed  
16 conflict in which it was engaged and who lost a limb or became totally  
17 blind in both eyes or became paralyzed as a result of such service All such  
18 vehicles or tractors except those owned and used by the Federal Govern-  
19 ment shall be titled and registered and shall display registration plates

**1** as is now provided for privately owned motor vehicles tractors trailers  
**2** and semi-trailers

**3** All vehicles titled and registered under the provisions of this sub-  
**4** section shall be operated and used exclusively for the purpose because  
**5** of which payment of fees was not required

**6** Penalty Any person violating any of the provisions of this sub-  
**7** section shall upon summary conviction before a magistrate be sentenced  
**8** to pay a fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and costs of prosecution  
**9** and in default of the payment thereof shall undergo imprisonment for  
**10** not more than ten (10) days
