AN ACT

Amending the act of June 11 1935 (P L 326) entitled "An act relating to counties of the first class defining deceased service persons providing for contributions by the county to the funeral expenses for such persons and their widows providing for the erection and care of markers headstones and flags and for the compilation of war records" changing the name of The Italian-American World War Veterans of the United States Incorporated DEPARTMENT OF PENNSYLVANIA to conform with its charter

17 prepare and file with the county commissioners certificates embodying
18 the information provided for in this section
