AN ACT

Amending the act of May 15 1874 (P L 186) entitled "An act declaring what offices are incompatible" making the OFFICES of mayor CONTROLLER AND TREASURER of third class cities and members of the legislature incompatible

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

3 Section 10 It shall not be lawful for any member of either branch
4 of the legislature to hold or to exercise the [office.] OFFICES of mayor
5 CONTROLLER OR TREASURER in any city of the third class or
6 councilman in any incorporated city of this commonwealth
