AN ACT

Amending the act of July 8 1957 (P L 579) entitled "An act establishing minimum compensation and increments for members of the faculty and administration of the Thaddeus Stevens Trade School and imposing duties on the Board of Trustees of such school and the Superintendent of Public Instruction" changing the salaries and increments of teachers and supervisors and providing for payment on a monthly basis.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

19 (1) Teachers holding a standard or college certificate valid for the
20 subjects or grades in which the teacher is giving instruction minimum

1 (3) Teachers of applied arts and vocational subjects who hold a
2 standard certificate shall be entitled to the same minimum salary and
3 increments as teachers who hold a college certificate

4 (4) Teachers of applied arts and vocational subjects who hold a
5 standard or college certificate and have earned an additional thirty
6 semester hours of credit in professional education in the teaching field
7 in which said teacher is engaged or related thereto shall be entitled
8 to the same minimum salary and increments as teachers holding a
9 master's degree

10 (5) The maximum salary required to be paid under the provisions
11 of this section shall not exceed the minimum annual salary plus the
12 sum of the total number of increments for the class

13 (6) Supervisors who devote one-half or more of their time to super-
14 vision of instruction holding a standard or college certificate for the
15 school year 1958-1959 minimum annual salary three thousand eight
16 hundred dollars (\$3,800) for the school year 1959-1960 four thousand
17 four hundred dollars (\$4,400) for the school year 1960-1961 four
18 thousand six hundred dollars (\$4,600) for the school year 1961-1962

15 Notwithstanding any other provisions of this act each teacher and
 16 supervisor whose salary and increments are fixed by this act and who
 17 is a member of the faculty or administration of the Thaddeus Stevens

 19 tion to the salary and increments otherwise prescribed by this act for
