AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum  
Commission to aid in the maintenance and operation of a shrine  
to house the replica of the Liberty Bell

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 The sum of five thousand dollars (~~\$5,000~~) ONE THOU-
- 2 SAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1500) or as much thereof as
- 3 may be necessary is hereby appropriated for the fiscal period beginning
