AN ACT

Amending the act of April 29 1959 (P L 58) entitled "An act consolidating and revising the Vehicle Code the Tractor Code the Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act and other acts relating to the ownership possession and use of vehicles and tractors" further regulating suspensions of operators' licenses or learners' permits for violation of maximum speed limits

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

EXPLANATION—CAPITAL LETTERS indicate new matter added to bill. Matter stricken through is to be omitted from bill. Underscoring indicates new matter added to existing law. [Brackets] indicate matter stricken from existing law.

1 Section 1 Clause (2) of subsection (b) of section 618 act of April 29
2 1959 (P L 58) known as "The Vehicle Code" is amended to read

3 Section 618 Suspension of Licenses or Operating Privileges

4 * * *

5 (b) The secretary may suspend the operator's license or learner's
6 permit of any person after a hearing before the secretary or his repre-
7 sentative whenever the secretary finds upon sufficient evidence

8 * * *

9 (2) That such person has committed any violation of the laws of
10 this Commonwealth relating to vehicles or tractors Provided That the
11 operator's license or learner's permit of any person shall not be sus-
12 pending for any violations of maximum speed limits except if the violator
13 has operated a vehicle on a highway at a speed in excess of fifty (50)
14 miles an hour AND PROVIDED FURTHER THAT IN ANY IN-
15 STANCE IN WHICH THE SPEED OF A VEHICLE IS TIMED
16 BY OFFICERS OF THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE
17 THROUGH THE USE OF RADIOMICROWAVES COMMONLY
18 REFERRED TO AS ELECTRONIC SPEED METERS OR RADAR
19 THE OPERATOR'S LICENSE OR LEARNER'S PERMIT OF ANY

1 PERSON SHALL NOT BE SUSPENDED FOR ANY VIOLATIONS
 2 OF MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS EXCEPT IF THE SPEED RE-
 3 CORDED IS SIX OR MORE MILES PER HOUR IN EXCESS OF
 4 THE LEGAL SPEED LIMIT

6 Section 2 This act shall take effect immediately
