A JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to article four section twenty-one of the
Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania changing
the time at which the Auditor General the State Treasurer and
the Secretary of Internal Affairs take office and permitting the
Auditor General and State Treasurer to succeed themselves for
one additional term

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
heraby resolves as follows

1 Section 1 The following amendment to the Constitution of the
2 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with the
3 provisions of the eighteenth article thereof

4 That section twenty-one article four of the Constitution of the
5 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania be amended to read

6 Section 21-A The terms of the Secretary of Internal Affairs the
7 Auditor General and the State Treasurer shall each be four years and
8 shall begin on the third Tuesday of January next following their election
9 and they shall be chosen by the qualified electors of the State at general
10 elections

11 Section 21-B Except for the Auditor General and State Treasurer
12 who may be in office when this amendment is adopted they shall be
13 eligible to succeed themselves for one additional term **THE SECRE-**
14 **TARY OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS MAY SUCCEED HIMSELF FOR**
15 **ANY NUMBER OF TERMS**

17 That no inconvenience may arise from the change in the Consti-
18 tution of the Commonwealth and in order to carry it into complete
19 operation it is declared that
