AN ACT

Amending the act of June 24 1939 (P L 872) entitled "An act to consolidate amend and revise the penal laws of the Commonwealth" further defining disorderly conduct in order to protect passengers lawfully occupying any railroad ~~or railway~~ RAILWAY ELEVATED RAILWAY OR SUBWAY passenger station BUS TERMINAL or platform

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

3 Section 407 Disorderly Conduct on Railway Cars Passenger Stations
4 Passenger Platforms BUS TERMINALS and at Picnic Grounds Who-
5 ever wilfully makes any loud boisterous and unseemingly noise or by
6 using obscene or profane language disturbs and annoys any one who
7 is a passenger upon any railroad or railway car or lawfully occupying
8 any railroad ~~or railway~~ RAILWAY ELEVATED RAILWAY OR
9 SUBWAY passenger station OR BUS TERMINAL or platform or a
10 visitor at any public or private park or picnic ground kept for the
11 amusement of the public whereby the public peace is broken or dis-
12 turbed or the public annoyed is guilty of the offense of disorderly con-
13 duct and upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding shall be
14 sentenced to pay the costs of prosecution and a fine not exceeding ten
15 dollars (\$10) and in default of the payment thereof shall be imprisoned
16 for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days

17 Any conductor in charge of any passenger train on a railroad shall
18 arrest on view any person so conducting himself in a disorderly manner
19 in such train and deliver such person into the custody of any constable
20 or any police officer for a hearing
