## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 24 1939 (P L 872) entitled "An act to consolidate amend and revise the penal laws of the Commonwealth" prohibiting the use of railroad RAILWAY ELEVATED RAILWAY AND SUBWAY passenger station AND BUS TERMINAL facilities by loiterers

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

EXPLANATION—CAPITAL LETTERS indicate new matter added to bill. Matter stricken through is to be omitted from bill. Underscoring indicates new matter added to existing law. [Bracketed] indicate matter stricken from existing law.

1 Section 1 The act of June 24 1939 (P L 872) known as "The Penal  
2 Code" is amended by adding after section 699.13 a new section to read  
3 Section 699.14 Loiterers in RAILROAD Railway ELEVATED  
4 RAILWAY SUBWAY Passenger Stations BUS TERMINALS and  
5 Platforms Any person who shall loiter idle or lounge in on or about any  
6 railroad ~~or~~ railway ELEVATED RAILWAY OR SUBWAY passenger  
7 station OR BUS TERMINAL or platform other than in the course  
8 of using it for the ~~purpose~~ PURPOSES OR SERVICES for which it  
9 exists AND WHICH IT OFFERS is guilty of a summary offense  
10 and upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding shall be  
11 sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding fifty dollars (\$50) and the cost  
12 of prosecution and in default of the payment thereof shall undergo  
13 imprisonment for not more than five (5) days
