AN ACT

Requiring funeral directors to notify the voters registration commission upon the burial of any person over twenty-one years of age and providing penalties

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 Upon the burial of any person over the age of twenty-
- 2 one years the funeral director in charge of the burial shall within
- 3 ten days notify the voters registration commission of the county IN

3 SECTION 2 SUCH NOTICE SHALL CONTAIN THE NAME
4 AND LAST KNOWN ADDRESS AND DATE AND PLACE OF
5 DEATH OF DECEASED SUCH NOTICE SHALL BE GIVEN ON
6 A FORM TO BE PROVIDED FREE OF CHARGE BY THE SAID
7 VOTERS REGISTRATION COMMISSION UPON REQUEST

8 Section 3 Any person violating the provisions of this act shall
9 be guilty of a ~~misdemeanor~~ SUMMARY OFFENSE and upon conviction thereof shall be sentenced to pay a fine of ~~fifty dollars (\$50)~~ TEN
10 DOLLARS (\$10) or undergo imprisonment for a period not exceeding
11 ~~ten~~ THREE days
