AN ACT

Amending the act of April 29 1959 (P L 58) entitled "An act consolidating and revising the Vehicle Code the Tractor Code the Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act and other acts relating to the ownership possession and use of vehicles and tractors" permitting motor vehicles OWNED AND used by certain photographers and cameramen PERSONS ENGAGED IN COLLECTING NEWS to be equipped with a warning light

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

6 (c) Any motor vehicle which is used by any person who is regularly
7 employed or engaged as a bona fide newspaper newsreel or film television
8 news photographer or cameraman OWNED BY ANY PERSON EN-
9 GAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF COLLECTING AND DISSEMI-
10 NATING NEWS THROUGH ANY NEWS MEDIA may be equipped
11 with not more than one (1) flashing amber warning light to be approved
12 by the secretary Such light shall be in use and operation only when
13 the motor vehicle is being used by such person OR HIS EMPLOYEE in
14 the pursuit of his regular employment in covering current news events
15 NEWS EMERGENCIES
