AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the committee appointed by the General  
Assembly to examine the issue of the abolition of capital pun-  
ishment in Pennsylvania

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 The sum of ~~ten thousand dollars (\$10,000)~~ SIX THOU-
- 2 SAND DOLLARS (\$6,000) or as much thereof as may be necessary
- 3 is hereby appropriated to the committee appointed by the General As-

1 ssembly pursuant to 1961 Senate Concurrent Resolution Serial No 101  
2 adopted by the Senate on February 8 1961 and concurred in by the  
3 House on February 14 1961 to make a thorough examination of the  
4 issue of the abolition of capital punishment in Pennsylvania The money  
5 shall be used for the payment of expenses of the committee and the  
6 members thereof in the performance of its functions and duties ONLY  
7 DURING THE CONTINUANCE OF THE 1961 SESSION OF THE  
8 GENERAL ASSEMBLY

9 SECTION 2 THE SUM APPROPRIATED SHALL BE PAID  
10 ON WARRANT OF THE AUDITOR GENERAL IN FAVOR OF  
11 THE CHAIRMAN OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON THE PRE-  
12 SENTATION OF HIS REQUISITION FOR THE SAME THE  
13 CHAIRMAN OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE SHALL NOT LATER  
14 THAN THIRTY DAYS AFTER THE TERMINATION OF HIS  
15 TERM OF OFFICE OR UNTIL HIS SUCCESSOR IS ELECTED  
16 AND ALSO WITHIN THIRTY DAYS AFTER THE ADJOURN-  
17 MENT SINE DIE OF THIS GENERAL ASSEMBLY FILE AN  
18 ACCOUNT WITH THE AUDITOR GENERAL OF THE COM-  
19 MITTEE'S EXPENSES SINCE THE FILING OF ANY PRIOR  
20 ACCOUNT

1 Section 2 3 This act shall take effect immediately
