AN ACT

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Sections 4 5 6 7 8 and 9 act of June 1 1956 (P L 1959)
2 entitled "An act fixing the salaries and compensation of the Chief Justice
3 and judges of the Supreme Court the President Judge and judges of
4 the Superior Court the judges of the courts of common pleas the judges

8 officers and the salary and expenses of the members of the General
9 Assembly and repealing certain inconsistent acts" are amended to read

10 Section 4 [The annual salary of each of the judges of the courts of
11 common pleas of the first and fifth judicial districts shall be twenty-
12 two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500)]

13 With the exception of the judges of the courts of common pleas of
14 Dauphin County the annual salary of each of the judges of the courts

1 of common pleas learned in the law in judicial districts having a popula-
2 tion of more than [two] one hundred and fifty thousand [and less than
3 one million] inhabitants shall be [twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000)]
4 twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) in judicial districts having a
5 population of one hundred thousand and more but less than [two]
6 one hundred fifty thousand inhabitants shall be [twenty thousand dol-
7 lars (\$20,000)] twenty-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$22,500) in
8 judicial districts having a population of sixty-five thousand or more and
9 less than one hundred thousand inhabitants shall be [nineteen thousand
10 dollars (\$19,000)] twenty-one thousand five hundred dollars (\$21,500)
11 in judicial districts having a population of less than sixty-five thousand
12 inhabitants [eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000)] twenty thousand five
13 hundred dollars (\$20,500) The amount of the salaries to be paid under
14 this paragraph in the several judicial districts shall be determined and
15 fixed according to the population of such districts as ascertained by
16 reference from time to time to the last preceding decennial United
17 States census

18 Section 5 The judges of the courts of common pleas of Dauphin
19 County and the judges of the orphans' court of Dauphin County shall

1 each receive [twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000)] twenty-seven
 2 thousand five hundred dollars (\$27,500) annually

3 Section 6 In any county where a separate orphans' court is es-
 4 tablished the annual salary of each judge of the orphans' court shall
 5 be the same as is paid to the judge or judges of the court or courts
 6 of common pleas in such county

7 Section 7 The annual salary of the President Judge of the Munic-
 8 ipal Court of Philadelphia shall be [eighteen thousand five hundred
 9 dollars (\$18,500)] twenty-three thousand dollars (\$23,000) and the
 10 annual salary of each of the other judges of the Municipal Court of
 11 Philadelphia shall be [eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000)] twenty-two
 12 thousand five hundred dollars (\$22,500)

13 Section 8 The annual salary of the President Judge of the County
 14 Court of Allegheny County shall be [eighteen thousand five hundred
 15 dollars (\$18,500)] twenty-one thousand dollars (\$21,000) TWENTY-
 16 THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$23,000) and the annual salary
 17 of each of the other judges of the County Court of Allegheny County
 18 shall be [eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000)] twenty thousand five
 19 hundred dollars (\$20,500) TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUN-
 20 DRED DOLLARS (\$22,500)

1 Section 9 The annual salary of the judge of the Juvenile Court of
 2 Allegheny County shall be [eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000)]
 3 ~~twenty thousand five hundred dollars (\$20,500)~~ TWENTY-TWO
 4 THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$22,500)

5 Section 2 This act shall take effect immediately
